
Brothers & Sisters in Christ,

In April 2002...

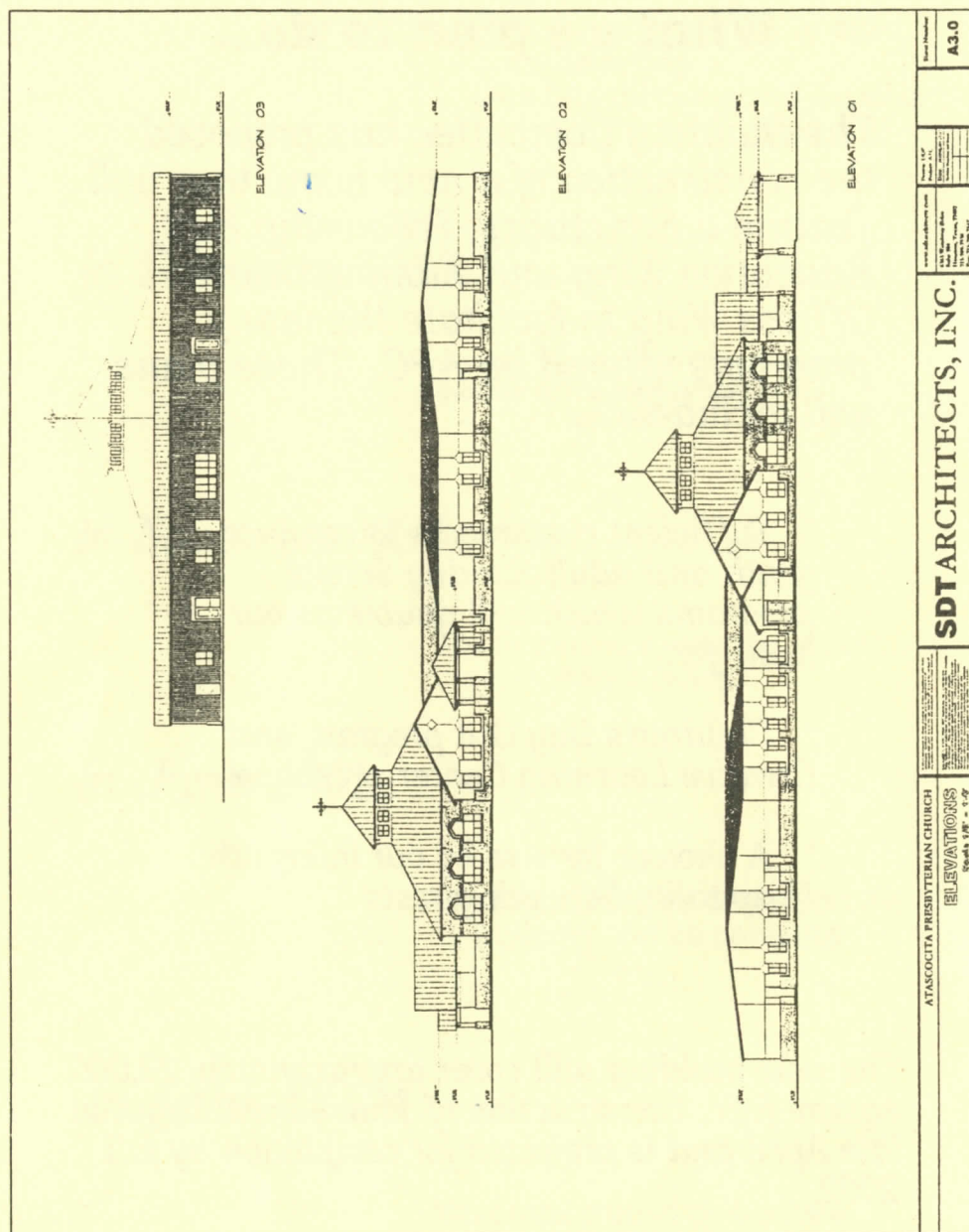
We break ground on our new

What we plan to do...

*The Building Committee has proposed
the construction of a new home that will
feature a Sanctuary, Fellowship Hall,
Education Wing and Administrative
Offices Wing to facilitate the many
programs offered by APC. These plans
will include:*

- ° Sufficient classrooms to conduct
youth and adult Sunday School
programs which will double as our
home for....*
- ° Children's Day Out program and
Creative Learning Center preschool*
- ° A shower for use by our Interfaith
Hospitality Network guests*

*The new building will cover approximately 22,000
square feet. Construction of Phase I will begin in
late April and is projected for completion by fall
2002.*

How we plan to raise the funds...

As you can see by the figures above, building a church to meet the current and future needs of our congregation is costly. The Atascocita area is projected to reach a population of 100,000 in the next ten years, giving us the opportunity to offer a church home to many new families.

Phase I will be completed with the following funds:

Insurance Proceeds and Gifts Received	\$930,000
Other Gifts and Grants	\$75,000
Mortgage Loans	\$350,000

Phase II will require a building fund drive. Your Session has approved a three-year capital campaign focused on raising the necessary funds to begin construction of our Sanctuary. We are being challenged to prayerfully consider a pledge of four percent of our total household income, **each year**, for the next three years beginning June, 2002. This commitment will be in addition to our current operating fund pledges and offerings.

The Campaign Committee recognizes the ability to give varies from family to family. Some may not have the resources to give at this level, while others may be able to give more. The Bible challenges us to give "each, according to his or her means". Through this principle of proportionate giving, the amount we pledge may be different, but the sacrifice is the same.
